## (Guideline for participants)

- 1. It is prohibited to record or distribute online JRAIA Symposium by any way (including taking photographs, screen captures (screen shots), video recording or voice recording) either live streaming or archive streaming.
- 2. It is prohibited to disclose participants' user ID, password, or viewer URL of JRAIA Symposium to non-registered participants. Sharing the screen while viewing or auditing the JRAIA Symposium either live streaming or archive streaming is also prohibited.

## [Guideline for presenters]

- 1. The copyright of full paper belongs to JRAIA but the copyright of presentation materials (slides) and presentation video belongs to the presenter.
- 2. Upon turning on the camera, please make sure the background does not include any copyrighted materials or work. Virtual background is highly recommended.
- 3. JRAIA Symposium is streamed on the Internet using public transmission. Please make sure all presenters do not include any photos or charts that would infringe copyright of others. If you wish to use them, please make sure that the source is clarified. (If you wish to use a quotation, you must clearly differentiate between the quotation and the quoting writer's own words. Quoting of the writer's own copyrighted work shall be the principal work, and the quoted copyrighted work of another person shall be considered an accessory work. Indication of the source is essential.)
- 4. If any photograph of a person is included in your presentation materials, please make sure to receive permission from the person him/herself, or edit the image so the figure cannot be identified. Any use of image of famous celebrities is prohibited. It is also forbidden to use photos of shrines, temples, artworks, celebrity figures, or a scene from a movie even if the photo was taken by yourself.

- 5. No background music is allowed.
- 6. JRAIA accepts no responsibility for any loss resulting from recording or distribution of the presentation without permission. Please make the presentation materials that would not cause any loss for unexpected recordings as a measure of precaution.
